Statement of Policy

It is LDCL policy to manage our obligations to the environment in a responsible manner and develop our land and drainage business to meet the needs of clients in a way which has due regard for the environment.

LDCL can influence the environment in two ways. Firstly, through responsible business practices and secondly, through the advice and consultancy that we provide. Our consultancy comprises of a team of staff whose backgrounds and qualifications are all environmentally orientated. The team are involved in campaigns to raise awareness of environmental issues, along with training to ensure the competence of staff.

It is our objective to:

- Continually improve the environmental performance of our activities and services.
- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation and any other environmental requirements which apply to our activities and services, alongside regularly assessing the company's adherence to these.
- Identify, understand and prioritize the environmental risks inherent in our business and allocate the necessary resources to ensure that these risks are managed effectively. Environmental aspects of all proposed projects are incorporated in all risk assessments, including planning and design (See Environmental Risk Assessment).
- Reduce waste and improve resource efficiency.
- Reduce water consumption and improve water efficiency.
- Endeavour to reduce and/or eliminate emissions and discharges into the environment.
- Take proactive measures to enhance, protect and preserve wildlife and flora, and their natural habitats.
- Set objectives, targets and programmes, and review and revise them regularly with the aim of continual improvement in environmental performance.
- Work with and contract environmentally creditable parties.
- Source local resources wherever and whenever possible.
